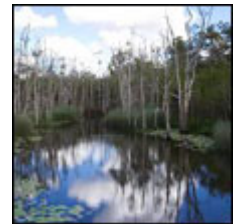
Natural Assets Local Law

Brisbane City Council's Natural Assets Local Law 2003 helps to protect our natural assets, including bushland, areas, wetlands, waterway corridors and trees in urban areas.

This law may affect you if you own or occupy land:

- near a river or a waterway
- in a bushland area
- in an emerging community (future urban land) with large trees
